Pete Doll retired as golf professional from Frankfort Country Club in 1980, ending a career that spanned 34 years at three locations. He began as the professional at Cherokee Golf Course and a year later moved on to Iroquois Golf Course, where he remained for 13 years. In 1960, he moved to Frankfort Country Club, where he remained until his retirement in 1980. He was the Kentucky PGA President from 1952-1953. As a player, he won the state's two most coveted crowns – the 1941 Kentucky State Amateur Championship and the 1956 Kentucky Open.
