



Jack Freeman – 2002

Jack Freeman served as head professional at Bellefonte Country Club in Ashland from 1967-2001. An all-around athlete, he was awarded a basketball scholarship to Marshall University and was a member of the 1956 MAC Championship squad. He also won the MAC individual golf title in 1957, and was elected into the Marshall University Hall of Fame in 1987. He won the 1977 Kentucky Open and was honored in 1988 by his peers in the Kentucky PGA as Golf Professional of the Year. He served two terms on the Kentucky PGA Board of Directors, and received the Horton Smith Award in 1997. He was also very instrumental in the formation of the American Junior Golf Association's (AJGA) Bluegrass Invitational at Bellefonte in 1984.
