



Gordon Leishman – 1998

A PGA Member for over 50 years, Gordon Leishman was head golf professional and golf course superintendent at River Road Country Club in Louisville from 1957 to 1964. He moved to Lexington where he was head professional at Idle Hour Country Club for the following 31 years. He won the Kentucky Open in 1963 and captured three Kentucky PGA titles (1959, 1966, and 1972). He served as Kentucky PGA President from 1962-1963, and Vice-President of the PGA of America from 1973-1974. He was also honored by the Kentucky PGA with the Horton Smith and Bill Strausbaugh Awards.
