



John Owens – 1986

John Owens compiled a very distinguished record as a player and as a leader. In 1965, he served as President of the Kentucky Golf Association, and also served as President of the Southern Golf Association from 1985-1987, and as a USGA Committee Member for over 25 years. Among his long list of accomplishments in golf are two Kentucky State High School Championships (1943 and 1944), ten Lexington City Amateur titles, thirteen Lexington Country Club Championships titles, fourteen Idle Hour Country Club Championship titles, three Kentucky Senior Amateur Championships, two Kentucky State Amateur Championships, an individual Southeastern Conference title at the University of Kentucky in 1950, and the 1984 British Senior Open Amateur Championship. Mr. Owens also competed in the 1964 Masters Tournament, and was inducted into the Kentucky Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002.
