



Betty Rowland Probasco – 1991

Betty Rowland Probasco, a resident of Kentucky for 23 years, captured four Women's Kentucky Amateur Championship titles (1949, 1951, 1952, and 1953). In 1950, she won the National Intercollegiate Championship, and in 1955 won the Women's Southern Golf Association Championship and was a semi-finalist in the U.S. Women's Amateur Championship. She also won the Women's Tennessee Amateur Championship eight times. In 1956, she was selected to the United States Curtis Cup Team, and served as Captain of the 1982 United States Curtis Cup Team. She is a member of the Kentucky Athletic Hall of Fame, the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame, the Tennessee Golf Hall of Fame and the Rollins College Sports Hall of Fame.
